## Projected use of the PE and Sports Premium 2017- 2018

The Government has increased the Sports Premium for 2017-2018 which means that the Academy is in receipt of - £19,450.

**The Academy would continue to invest £7,032 from its annual budget**

**This would mean a predicted spend of £26,482 to enhance the PE provision for the children in the academy**

**At The GSA this additional funding would enable us to continue to provide the high quality sports provision with a particular emphasis on**

- increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
- Increasing the range of sports offered as extracurricular clubs
- Increasing further the pupil participation across the younger years
- To have a whole school sports week where lots of outside providers deliver expert sessions in a wide range of different sports to encourage enjoyment, interest, discover talent and encourage the children to want to continue to be active.
- Providing additional, high quality apparatus for the playground to encourage the children to be active throughout playtimes
- CPD for staff, including support staff and MDSA's to enable them to become Play Leaders on the playground during break times.

To purchase additional PE apparatus for play time use for all key stages	£2500
Extra-Curricular activities for the Key stage 1 children	£482
