The children will be taking part in lots of fun activities throughout the day including: a special Jubilee lunch, craft activities, learning about our Queen as a servant leader and looking at other leaders of our time.

All children are invited to come to school dressed in clothes from any decade of Her Majesty's reign – from the 1950's through to the present day.

Class	Contribution
Year 3	Shop bought cakes e.g. donuts, cupcakes (no nuts please)
Class 4SD	Cordial (blackcurrant or orange)
Class 4MT	Crisps (multipack)
Year 5	Crisps (multipack)
Year 6	Strawberries (1 punnet per child)

We will of course ensure children with allergies are catered for during the picnic. However, if you would prefer to, you are more than welcome to send them with a packed lunch from home.

The day will culminate in a short concert on the school field at 3pm to which you are very welcome to attend. Children in each year group will perform a song representing each decade of the Queen's reign.
