Welcome to Year 5! The children have already made a brilliant start to the school term. We have lots to look forward to and can't wait to get to know you all throughout the school year.

Mathematics

We follow the White Rose program at Good Shepherd. We practise fluency before tackling problems, with a focus on providing reasoning and depth of understanding. This term we are focusing on: place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and fractions.

Knowing basic times tables and division facts are vital to year 5, please support your child in practising these regularly.

We also look forward to our 'Mission Day' on Monday 26th September where we will begin to explore our new school mission.



In Science, we will be studying Earth and Space. During these lessons, we will learn about the movement of the planets using the Sun, Moon and



Earth as our reference points. We will also relate the movement of the planets to the causes of seasons and the cycle of day and night. To conclude this topic, we will be creating a model of the Solar System.

Our geography topic for this half term is Changes to Nottingham and the UK. Within this topic, we will learn about how population changes, especially within Nottinghamshire. We will discuss some of the factors which affect population, such as migration and life expectancy.

In the second half term our history topic will be Britain's settlement by the Anglo-Saxons and Scots. We will learn about the time period when the Anglo-Saxons and Scots arrived in Britain, focusing on their arrival and settlement as well as their change in religion.



English

This term we will be writing: rap poems, nonchronological reports and persuasive leaflets linked to our Earth and Space topic. Next half term we will be writing: warning stories and playscripts linked to Beowulf.

Our class text is 'There's a Boy in the Girls' Bathroom' by Louis Sachar. We will also be reading 'Hidden Figures' by Margot Lee Shetterley and 'Beowulf'. We will also be sharing a range of other texts in our reading for pleasure time.

Please continue to support your child by talking to them about books and listening to them read.



Homework

Children should be reading at home **every** day for around 15 - 20 minutes. It is very important that you please read with your children at home and make a note in their Homework Diary.

Times tables should be practised daily. Children have their login details for Times Tables Rock Stars in their reading diaries.

As well as daily reading and times tables, children will receive weekly spellings, a maths task, and a knowledge organiser task. This work will consolidate their learning from the week which will help them retain new knowledge.

Homework and spellings will be given out on a **Friday** and completed homework books are to be returned the following **Wednesday**. Spellings will be tested every Friday.

Nuts

Please be aware that no nuts or nut products are permitted on the school premises or on trips. This is because a number of pupils have severe nut allergies. Thank you for helping us keep everyone safe.

P.E. Day
