I hope you are well. Further to my newsletter on 22nd February, I wanted to write to give you some further information about our upcoming Lenten almsgiving activities.

Adoration – Tuesday 14th March – 10am

Next Tuesday morning, children in Years 4, 5 and 6 will take part in an Adoration service in church. This is a beautiful opportunity for us to encounter Jesus during Lent. We will spend around 45 minutes in quiet reflection as we take time to worship Jesus, present in the eucharistic host. Please do join us if you can.

Reception Mothers' Day Liturgy, Tea and Cake – Friday 17th March

The children in reception are delighted to invite their mummies (and other family members) to share a liturgy with them on 17th March – 10am for RAW and 2pm for RKD. **Please note, this is open to reception families only.**

Lenten Reflection Day – Monday 20th March

Children across school will take part in a day of spiritual reflection to explore the key themes of Lent – to fast, to pray and to give alms. We will look closely at the Easter story and what Jesus' sacrifice means for us today.

Reconciliation Service – Thursday 23rd March at 9.30am in school

Fr Philipp will join us for a Reconciliation Service on 23rd March, giving children in Years 4, 5 and 6 the opportunity to receive the sacrament as part of their Lenten journey. Parents are very welcome to join us in the hall at 9.30am.

Stations of the Cross – Sunday 26th March at 12pm in Church

Please join us as we hold a family Stations of the Cross service in Church on 26th March at 12pm. Children will take on the roles of the different people of the time as we follow the way of the cross. If you are able to attend, please complete <u>this link</u> by Monday 20th March so we have an idea of the number of families that will be joining us and can distribute readings etc in good time.

Each year group has produced a piece of art work to represent the stations of the cross, which will be displayed in church from 21st March to the end of Lent.

Sponsored Walk for Turkey and Syria – CAFOD Humanitarian Appeal – Tuesday 28th March

This time last year, I was so humbled to witness the generosity of our school community when we came together to support the people of Ukraine. By donating food, toiletires and clothing and raising a staggering £3000, we certainly lived out our school mission to serve others.

This year, we will show our generosity again by raising money for CAFOD in support of the people of Turkey and Syria whose lives were affected by the earthquakes in early February. Some statistics:

- 52,700 people are known to have died across both countires many more are still unaccounted for.
- Tens of thousands of people have suffered life changing injuries.
- Hundreds of thousands of people have lost their homes.
- there are 4.6 million children in the earthquake-affected areas of Turkey, with more than 2.5 million children affected in Syria.

Therefore on Tuesday 28th March, we ask that **children come to school in non-uniform, with the colours red and white represented** (as per the Turkish and Syrian flags). As last year, each year group will spend an hour walking (jogging or running!) round the perimeter of the Helicopter Park, counting their laps as they go. **A sponsor form has been sent home with your child on Monday.** Parents are more than welcome to join us as we walk – it would be great to see you. Class	Activity	
Nursery	Creating Easter cards for each class in school, delivering them themselves!	
Reception	Weaving Easter baskets and making Easter crafts to send to vulnerable young people in our community.	
Year 1	Go on a walk round the local area, leaving behind messages of hope and joy on painted stones.	
Year 2	Litter pick in school and around the local area	
Year 3	Posting heart shaped cookies and Lenten prayers through the door of those in our community	
Year 4	Attend Monday morning mass and offer it to the SVP. Also take Easter cards and gifts to share with the lonely and housebound in our parish community.	
Year 5	Making up rucksacs of essentials for the homeless and giving them to the charity, Emmanuel House	
Year 6	Year 6 are posting prayer request cards to streets around Woodthorpe. Prayer requests received back will be taken to the Briars to pray for.
