New Trust Attendance Policy.

The OLoL Trust have recently updated the Attendance and Punctuality Policy (including corresponding template letters) which is attached along with this newsletter. The policy is very clear on our expectations that children attend school every day (unless they are too unwell). It also clearly states that leave of absence will only be granted in exceptional circumstances. Please note, an unauthorised leave of absence of more than 3 days/6 sessions (over a 6-week rolling period) may lead to you being issued with a penalty notice fine via Nottinghamshire County Council.
