- Homework is an essential way to revisit learning so we will continue to send homework out each week on a Wednesday. This will be checked on the following Wednesday.
- Children will be reminded to ensure presentation and handwriting is carried out to their best ability, following our Letter-join scheme.
- Homework will include: spellings, a maths activity and a knowledge organiser task linked to the topic work.
- We will be testing the children on their spellings on Wednesdays.
- Children should be reading at home EVERY day and be making a note in their organiser.

Music

Children will continue to have their weekly music session with Mr Fox where they will learn key skills including reading rhythm and performing different pieces of music.
