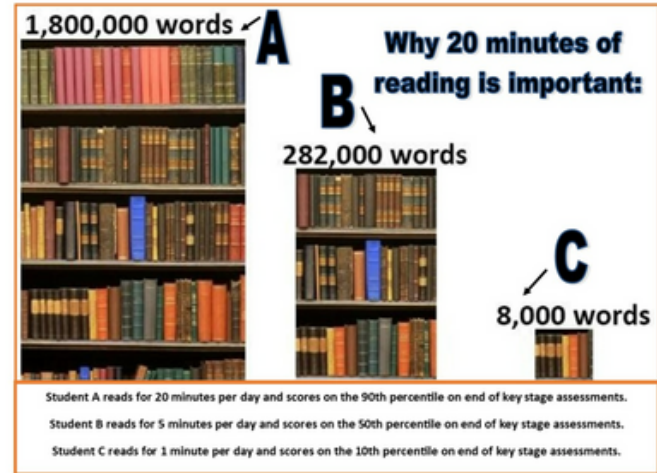
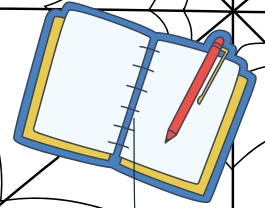
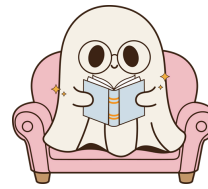




READING ORGANISERS

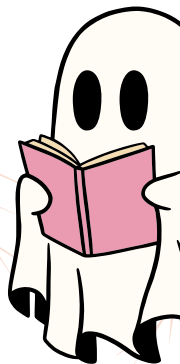
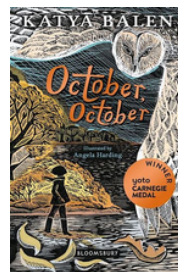
