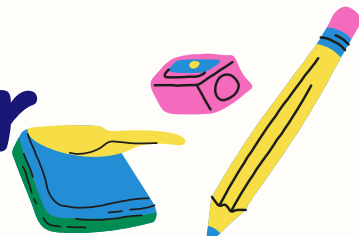




The Ark Class Newsletter Lent 2026

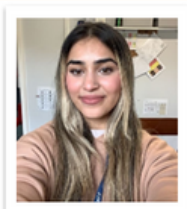

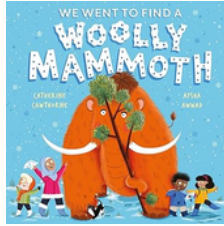
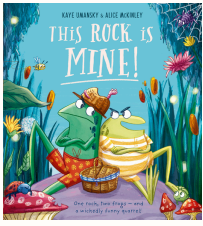

English

The texts we have studied so far:



We have focused on the features of instructions as well as retelling and sequencing, common and proper nouns, speech and adjectives.

Next half term we will be studying diary entries and learning all about how we write in first person.

Some pupils continue to access personalised daily objectives

8:45 - 9:00 - Soft start and 1:1 reading

9:00 - 9:45 - Maths teaching and task. Individual target practise.

9:45 - 10:15 - Discovery in enhanced provision and social target time.

10:15 - 10:30 - snack and drink time. Children take in turns to lead a conversation using 'would you rather' prompts.

10:30 - 10:45 - All children go out to play

10:45 - 11:30 - English teaching and task. Individual target practise.

11:30 - 11:45 - Discovery time

11:45 - Children have lunch in The Ark.

Maths

This term in maths we have been focusing on:

- Addition and subtraction - mental and written methods
- 2D and 3D shapes and lines of symmetry

Next half term we will continue with:

- Money and problem solving
- Multiplication and division

Some pupils continue to access personalised daily objectives

Enhanced Provision

During their morning in the Ark, the children have access to different areas to enhance their learning including:

- Role play
- Sensory messy play
- Construction
- Arts and crafts

These areas are linked to our key texts and concepts.
