
OUR CURRICULUM

English - Reading & Writing

This term, our class text is **'Who Let the Gods Out'** by **Maz Evans**. We will also read and study a range of fiction, non-fiction and poetry.

As part of our writing lessons, we will study the following units:

Write a diary as Covington, write our own Greek myths, inspired by Theseus and the Minotaur and write a monologue about peace.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Our keys topics this term are 'Galilee to Jerusalem' and 'Desert to Garden'.

In each of these topics, the children will focus their learning on the Gospel of John where they will learn about Jesus' miracles and the events of Holy Week.

MATHS

This term will be focusing on the following maths units:

- Fractions, decimals and percentages
- Algebra
- Converting measures
- Shape, space and measure

Throughout the year, we will regularly practice key facts which will support the children with their arithmetic skills. It is vital that children continue to use TTRS to ensure their times tables recall is strong. You can find their login details at the front of their homework diaries.
