The more engaged the children are with their revision, the more successful they will be in the tests. Thank you.

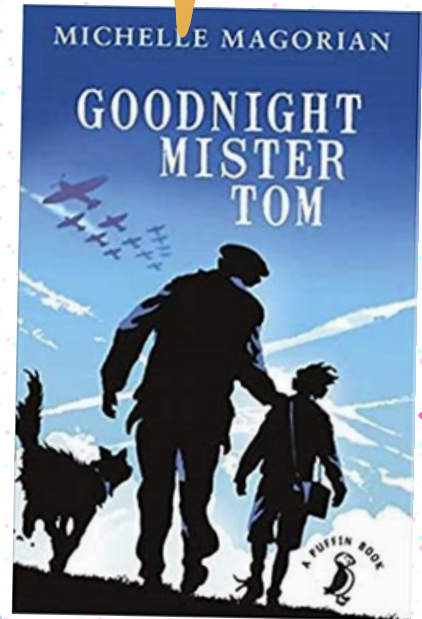
# OUR CURRICULUM

## English - Reading & Writing

This term, our class text is **Goodnight Mr. Tom** by **Michelle Magorian**. We will also read and study a range of fiction, non-fiction and poetry.

As part of our writing lessons, we will study the following units:

Write a monologue about peace, write Shakespearian sonnets, write letters as evacuees and write a balanced argument about evacuation.



## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Our key topics this term are called 'To the Ends of the Earth' and 'Encounter and Dialogue'.

The children will explore the events which took place after Good Friday, understanding how others bear witness to the resurrection of Jesus through their actions. They will explore how they can also be good witnesses to the life and work of Jesus.

- Transition - getting maths ready for secondary school.

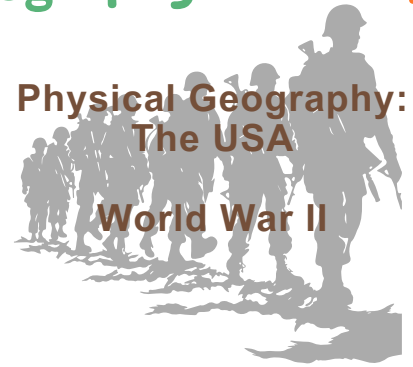

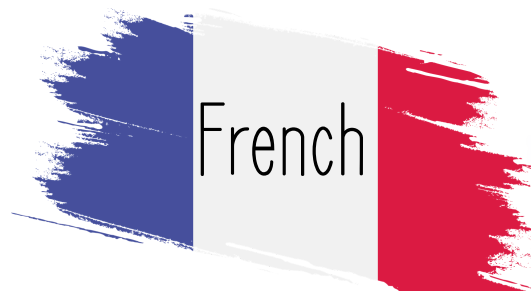
